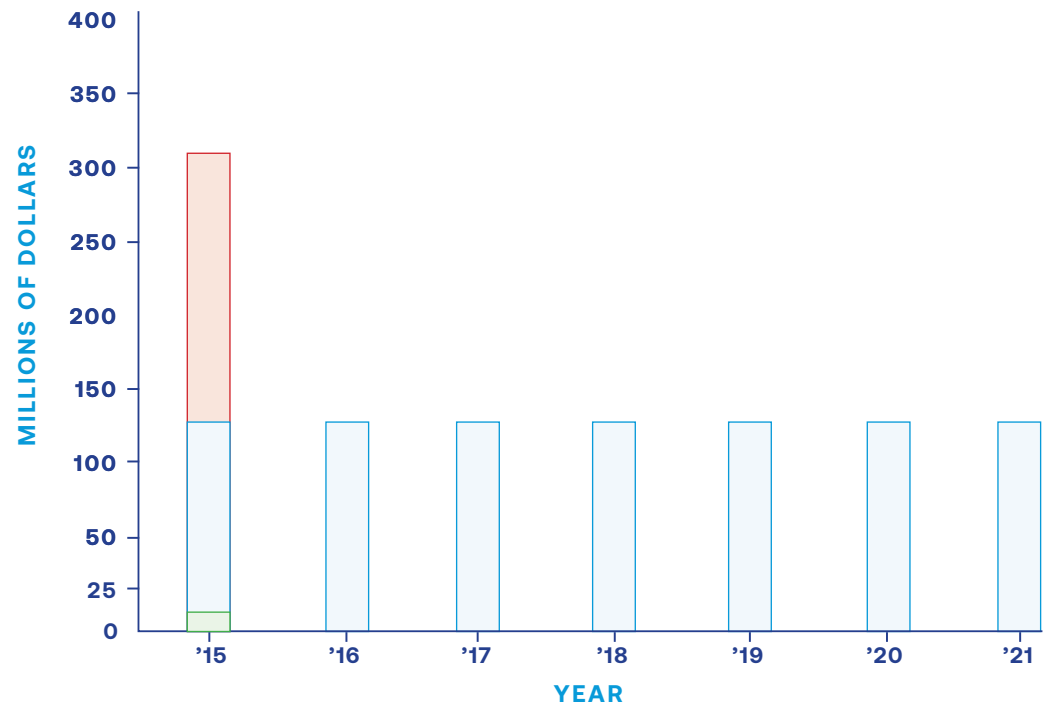
- 1 Use the data in the chart to complete the graph.
