What is a TRU Ambassador?

Ambassadors are a core group of TRU members who serve as youth leaders within the TRU movement for an entire school year. Ambassadors help to shape the TRU program by offering feedback on activities and highlighting any tobacco trends they see around their school & community. They also assist with and participate in TRU events, including our annual Day at the Capitol.



Requirements of being a TRU Ambassador:

- Be passionate about tobacco-free lifestyles
- Participate in a monthly conference call
- Organize and take part in TRU Storms & other events
- Attend Day at the Capitol
- Volunteer to help with social media campaigns, media interviews & other special projects throughout the year
- Be ready to make a change!
